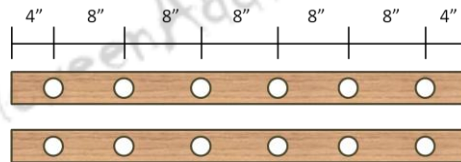
Wrought Iron Fence Prop

Materials:

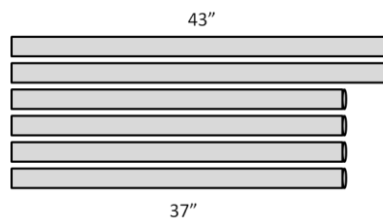
- 2 – 10' PVC, ½" Electric (Gray)
- 2 – ¼"x1½"x 4' Lathe Strips (sold in bundle)
- 4 – 4d nails (or small gauge wire)
- 1 can black spray paint



- 1) Drill 6 evenly spaced 3/4" or 13/16" holes in each piece of lathe for the PVC to fit through. (Space the holes at the end half the distance, as another section of fencing will sit next to it.)

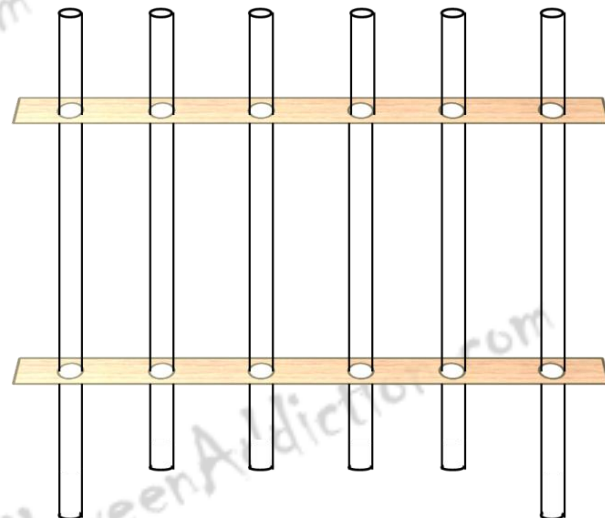


- 2) Cut one 43" and two 37" pieces of PVC out of each 10' PVC pipe. This will provide you a total of two 43" pipes and four 37" pipes which sit in between. Drill a small 3/32" hole through each of the 43" pipes, 6" and 30" from the same end. (Small 4d nails go through these holes to hold the lathe up in step 4.)



- 3) Set the lathe on the ground, and pound the two 43" pipes through the holes on either end into the ground to a depth of 6".

- 4) Pull the lathe up above the 3/32" holes and insert a 4d nail into each. Place two more nails into the upper holes, and place the second piece of lathe above.



- 5) Slide the four 37" pipes into the center 4 holes. Fine tune so it appears that all pipes have the same height.

- 6) Spray paint all exposed parts black.

- 7) Repeat the above steps for each 4' section of fence that you wish to create.
